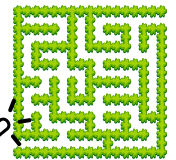
**FREE HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES!**

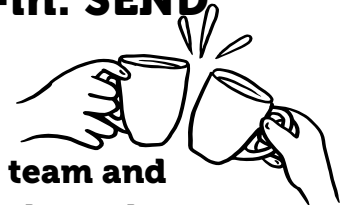
